

General Observations of Survey Data Comparing Full Time to Part Time Resident Responses

- Full time residents tend to be those living in Ancram longer (>20 years) while more part time residents have lived here < 20 years.
- More part time residents are from non-hamlet areas.
- More part time residents work 25+ miles from home.
- Full time residents had more people born here; more part timers here due to camp/vacation/scenery/bought home here.
- Only slight differences between full and part time residents on vision and goals. There were slightly more full timers that feel green and renewable energy is not important than part timers. More part timers feel climate smart programs are important
- More part timers felt that encouraging 'all types of agriculture' is not important than full timers. This was a fairly large difference between them.
- More part timers feel it is important to encourage a higher standard of property care through town laws in Ancram hamlet than full timers.
- More part timers support an Ancram hamlet planning group. This was a large difference between them.
- More part timers support town grants and other funding for programs.
- More full timers felt that constructing sidewalks is not important – much more importance for this topic from part timers. This was a large difference between them.
- In Ancramdale, more full timers did not think it was important for pedestrian crossing at Farmers Wife or for more street lighting. Part timers felt this was important.
- Like in Ancram, more part timers felt it was important to have an Ancramdale planning group.
- In Boston Corner, more part timers had no opinion on whether to allow businesses here than full timers who felt it was important.
- Part timers were more supportive of marking walking and bike lanes on roads, and for having a Boston Corner Hamlet Planning Group.
- For almost all the recreation topics, more part timers felt they were important than full timers. Full timers felt hunting and fishing were more important than part timers. Part timers had less support for improvements at Blass Field. Part timers had more support for increasing awareness of CLC lands.
- More full timers felt affordable housing was important to them or their family than part timers.
