

Proposed Resolutions – 10/15/20

1. 2021 Final Budget Public Hearing: Resolved, that the Ancram Town Board will hold a public hearing on the proposed 2021 Final Budget at 6.45 pm on November 19, 2020 via ZOOM.

2. 2021 Community Rescue Squad Budget – Resolved, that the Ancram Town Board approves the 2021 Community Rescue Squad budget request for a payment from Ancram of \$106,528 for rescue squad services in 2021, and it is further resolved that the Ancram Town Supervisor is authorized to enter into a chargeback agreement with the Columbia County Treasurer's Office to charge Ancram property tax payers for \$106,528 as part of the county tax levy and disburse these funds to the Community Rescue Squad.

3. Speed limits – Whereas, the volume of car and truck traffic has increased significantly on town and county roads in the Town of Ancram in the past 6 months, and whereas much of this increased traffic is unfamiliar with town and county roads, and whereas slow moving agricultural vehicles regularly use town and county roads, and whereas some sections of town and county still have posted speed limits of 55 mph or are unposted, allowing a 55 mph speed limit, and whereas a 55 mph speed limit is dangerous and inappropriate on these roads, **therefore it is resolved** that all town roads that have posted speed limits of over 40 mph or do not have a posted speed limit be changed to a posted speed limit of 40 mph, and that it is further that all county roads with a posted speed limit over 45 mph be changed to a posted speed limit of 45 mph, and be if further resolved that that the Town Highway Superintendent submit the necessary request to the County Highway Department and State DOT to approve these speed limit changes.

4. Geothermal RFP – Resolved, that the town Supervisor is authorized to enter into an agreement with CPL Engineering to assist the Town in the development of an RFP for a geothermal HVAC system at Town Hall for a cost not to exceed \$1500.

5) Building Inspector Compensation – Resolved, that Ed Ferratto will be paid \$2600 in compensation for the extra hours he worked as the Town Building Inspector during the months of June, July and August 2020.
