

Draft Resolutions – 10/21/2021

1) Enhanced Enforcement Patrols (EEPs) – Resolved, that the Town Supervisor is authorized to arrange with the County Sheriff's Department to continue two shifts per week at a cost of about \$1000 per week through the end of December, 2021, and **be if further Resolved**, that the EEPs will be requested to place a special emphasis on controlling the speed of large trucks on 82 through the hamlets of Ancram and Ancramdale and on County Routes 8, 8a and 3.

2 Final Budget Public Hearing - Resolved, that a public hearing on the 2022 Final Budget will be held at 6.45 pm on Thursday, November 18, 2021 at the Ancram Town Hall.

3) Marijuana Law – Resolved, that the Ancram Town Board adopts Local Law # 2 of 2021 which opts out of allowing on-site marijuana consumption sites in the Town of Ancram as authorized under Cannabis Law Article 4.

4) Resolution Supporting Inclusion and Understanding - WHEREAS, recently as a nation we have witnessed high violence based upon a person's religion, race, gender identities, sexual orientation, nationality, economic status and political affiliation; and **WHEREAS**, here in the United States, inclusive communities rely upon the guidance, assistance and leadership of people of all races, religions, nationalities, gender identities, sexual orientations, economic status, and political affiliation; and **WHEREAS**, the Ancram Town Board continues to maintain that all people have the right to feel safe and be treated equally and with respect and dignity regardless of their race, religion, nationality, gender identity, sexual orientation, economic status and political affiliation. **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that we members of the Ancram Town Board, on behalf of our community members, do hereby reaffirm our commitment to including all races, religions, nationalities, gender identities, sexual orientations, economic statuses and political affiliations in Town government and in the fabric of our community; and **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that on behalf of all residents of the Town of Ancram. we denounce violence of any kind and condemn any act of aggression, hostility or violence against any member of our community.

5) RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION for MARIE MCDERMOTT - RESOLVED, that the Ancram Town Board recognizes and appreciates the valuable contributions that Marie McDermott has made to the Town of Ancram over the 20 years of her public service, thanks her for her commitment to the Ancram Community, and wishes her continued success in all her future activities.

6) Community Rescue Squad 2022 Budget – Resolved, that the Ancram Town Board approves the proposed Ancram share of the Community Rescue Squad 2022 Budget of \$119,572 and authorizes the Town Supervisor to arrange with the County Treasurer to pay this amount to the Community Rescue Squad and allocate the amount of the budget to Ancram taxpayers via the County tax levy.

7) Technology Committee – Resolved, that Steve Olyha, Philip Hack, Doug Brenner and Michael Del Rossi are appointed to the Ancram Technology Committee, and be it further **resolved** that Steve Olyha will serve as Chair of the Ancram Technology Committee.
