Ancramdale Neighbors used the van to conduct 15 round trips to the Regional Food Bank in Latham NY over the 2nd quarter of 2024.

Jose Ayala served as the driver for each of these trips and was paid the contracted amount of \$250.00 from the 2024 Town Support Grant per round trip. We brought back an average of 2358 pounds of food each week, which was distributed to local Ancram Township Individuals and families or shared with the Pine Plains and/or Hillsdale food pantries. On average during this period we had 18 families come to the pantry each Monday.

We also used the van for three additional trips during this quarter to pick up donated household goods, donated fresh produce or durable donated packaged foods, two trips locally in the county and the third, a trip to a Brooklyn food distributor to pick up 6500 pounds of durable canned and dry goods, donated to us from a local Pine Plains couple. What donated household goods we cannot place with local families in need we pass on to Columbia County Habitat for Humanity.

In closing, we are again financing the lunch and snack program for Ancram's Summer camp and have given an initial grant of \$3000.00 to the Director for use weekly in purchasing the needed foods. We will report back to you at the end of the camp with final grant amounts.
