Diesel Fuel used: 645 gallons

*We have been busy with snow and or ice operations on 11 separate days in January an 6 to date in February as of 2/13. Our salt and sand supplies are adequate Salt deliveries have been slow to arrive but haven't been a problem due to our increased storage capacity with the new building.

*We patrolled roads for downed tree limbs after numerous high wind events.

* We continue to go over and make any repairs necessary on our equipment to be ready for the next weather event.

*New plow truck update: build date for the chassis is 3/19/25 we had to fill out a request for a waiver to the NYS zero emissions mandate. Hopefully, a good sign it's going to be built.

*I'm afraid our dirt roads are going to become very muddy this year when warmer weather comes. For the first time in 3-4 years, they have been frozen where the frost has gone deep and when it begins to thaw, the mud is going to be bad.

*I have signed an Intermunicipal agreement with the Village of Millerton to cover their use of our 2018 Ram pickup and plow until they no longer need it or they get a new one. Also, the agreements we have with the county and state are due for renewal and I will be signing and filing them when I receive them.
